HKJC provides dining, social, sport and recreation facilities to its more than 23,000 members. The Club is also Hong Kong's largest single taxpayer, contributing a record HK\$20.05 billion with its donations reached a record HK\$3.87 billion in 2014/15. With about 70% of its revenue given back to society every year through donations and tax contributions, HKJC delivers a significantly higher return to the community than any other racing and/or sports betting organisation in the world. As a socially responsible organisation, the Club helps Government combat illegal betting and advocates responsible gambling. The Club is also one of Hong Kong's largest employers with over 24,000 full-time and part-time staff.

In the 2nd week of 2016, Dr. Kim Mak, Executive Director, Corporate Affairs, HKJC accompanied a delegation led by Chief Secretary for Administration, Mrs. Carrie Lam, to visit Sichuan where it reviewed the HKSAR Government's work in support of reconstruction.
