The Future of Food theme and increased social media brought in 907 submissions and a greater alignment with Nobel for the grand final.




The Future of Truth allows us to align with Nobel. We will launch in Sep 2017.

 - Top 5 will present their ideas & • information they submitted to Regional judges


Regional Prize: \$1000, 800, 500 USD
