Competition Format

- You should observe the following:
 - 1st round competition Your team is required to submit a business proposal in PowerPoint format. The maximum number of slides is 10. The final deliverable should be in PDF/PPT Format with less than 20MB. Top 10 teams will be shortlisted for the final round competition. Case topics and proposal submission methods will be announced later.
 - Final round competition Your team will be required to deliver a 10-minute presentation to the judges in English. You can prepare PowerPoint slides to facilitate your presentation. A 5-minute Q&A session will be followed.
