### Rules for Participants (Hong Kong, Japan, Macau, Mongolia, South Korea, Taiwan)

- All participants must be full-time undergraduates (including diploma program) enrolled at the participating university / college in the competition year. There is no limit to the number of teams that may be fielded by a university / college.
- 2. Each team should consist of four students and could be from different faculties.
- 3. All members of each team must be the same university / college, and each participant can only join one team.
- 4. Students from all faculties are allowed to participate in Global Business Challenge 2023.
- 5. Each team must have a team leader.
- 6. Each team must have a team name and a slogan in English.

#### GBC 2023 Semi-Final (Macau)

- The Champion team will represent Macau to compete in the GBC 2023 North Asia Final.

#### GBC 2023 North Asia Final

- The winning teams from Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau, Japan, South Korea, Taiwan and Mongolia will be competing in the GBC 2023 North Asia Final.
