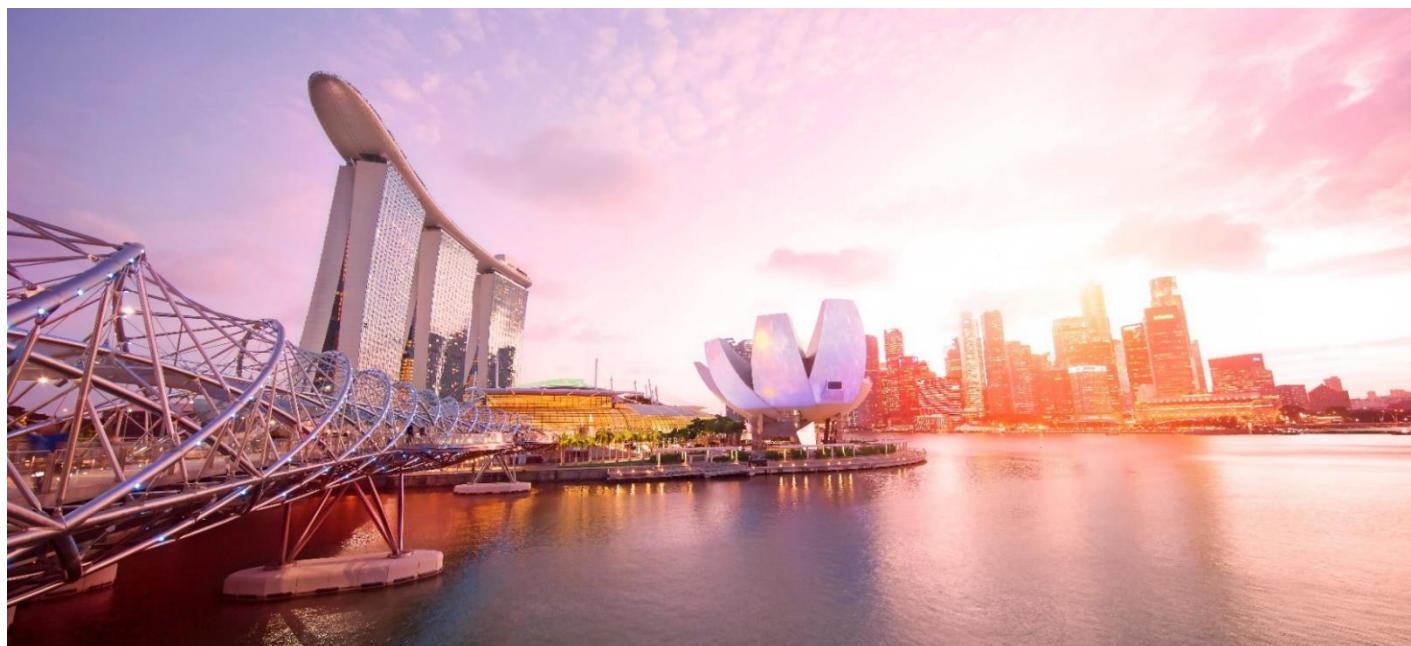

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who can register for this competition?

A: The competition is open to all undergraduates based in Singapore and Hong Kong. Full-time postgraduate students from local universities, colleges, or institutes of vocational education etc., are not eligible to enter the competition.

Q: How many people make up one team?

A: Each team must consist of exactly four members to be able to participate. Unfortunately, we are not able to find a team for individual sign-ups.

Q: Can I team up with participants from other universities?

A: Yes, your team can include students from different universities within Singapore & Hong Kong. However, teams with members from both countries are not allowed.

Q: Can I team with participants from other years of study?

A: Yes, your team can include students across all years of undergraduate study, including freshmen.
