



Rules & Important Information (1/2)

Team Formation

- University students from all disciplines and years of study are welcome to form teams of 2 to 3 members and submit one joint application per team.
- There is no limit to the number of teams that can apply from the same university. However, each student may only participate in one team.

Application

- Applications and CVs must be submitted by 14 July (Monday). Late responses will not be accepted.
- To register, ensure that you provide all necessary information about your team and each team member, and submit only one application per team via the registration form.
- Along with completing the registration form, please send each team member's CV to esq@polymercapital.com before the registration deadline.

Preliminary Screening

- All complete and on-time applications will be screened.
- Preference will be given to those with relevant background and experience.
- Following the preliminary CV screening, up to 3 teams from each university may be selected to advance to Round 1.

Rules & Important Information (2/2)

Virtual Orientations

- There will be **two rounds of virtual orientations** one for each round of competition.
- Teams selected for each round are required to attend their respective orientation session to learn about the case, judging criteria and rundown, and to receive a tailored lecture on ESG investing and the case topic.
- All teams may ask questions and seek clarification about the case during each orientation.

Round 1 Deliverables and Expectations

- Up to 3 teams from each university may be selected to enter Round 1.
- Shortlisted teams will submit your pitch deck (pdf) and presentation video.

Round 2 Deliverables and Expectations

- **Up to 5 teams** will be selected to enter Round 2.
- Prior to the competition, finalist teams will submit your pitch deck (pdf).
- During the competition, finalist teams will present to our judges and participate in a live Q&A session.

Note: Judging criteria for Round 1 and Round 2 will be explained separately in the respective orientation. Please refer to the competition timeline regarding the orientation schedule, submission deadline and final presentation.
