Please complete the form after you receive the email.

The applicants will be requested to upload the following materials for COE application:

1. Digital ID Photo

The ID photo should be taken within the last 3 months.

The photo must meet all specifications with the instruction.

The photo must not same as the one used for your passport.

 Bank balance certificate of yourself or your supporter's
 If you receive a scholarship/grant as your financial support, please submit an official document in English proving the amount and period that you receive it.

Once your application is completed, we will apply for the COE on your behalf, and your COE will be issued in around 1 to 3 months depending on the congestion of the immigration office. As soon as receiving your COE, we will send it to you. Please contact the nearby Japanese embassy or consulate for the visa application after receiving your COE.

Students who do not receive any email in the expected period are advised to check their e-mail folders including SPAM or advertisement mailbox because it could fail to reach the main mailbox.

Please note that submitting the COE application will not guarantee your acceptance to the exchange program of Kobe University in Japan.
