INCOMING EXCHANGE STUDENTS

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Partner institutions can nominate their students on our nomination website.

We send an email in March and August every year to our partner institutions with their login and password as well as the documents their students will need to upload on their application form.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE & REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Once nominated by their home institution, applicants to KEDGE will automatically receive an email with instructions on how to access the application form: <https://exchanges.kedge.edu/Welcome.aspx>

- Copy of passport (non-EU and EU students) or national identity card (EU students only) valid for the whole length of their stay.
- Proof of their English level (document provided by KEDGE and filled out by the home institution) or TOEFL score copy (minimum 79 IBT or 550), or IELTS score copy (minimum 6.0) or TOEIC score copy (minimum 785) or Cambridge First Certificate (B2).
- Proof of their academic level (document provided by KEDGE and filled out by the home institution).
- For students wishing to take French taught courses: proof of B2 level (document provided by KEDGE and filled out by the Home Institution) or official B2 language test score.

VISA

NON-EU STUDENTS

- **Step 1** : check whether you need to go through [the Etudes en France \(EEF\) procedure](#) before applying for your VISA (depending on your country of residence, you may not be affected by this procedure).
- **Step 2** : Apply for a VLS-TS student visa on the [French visa platform](#).

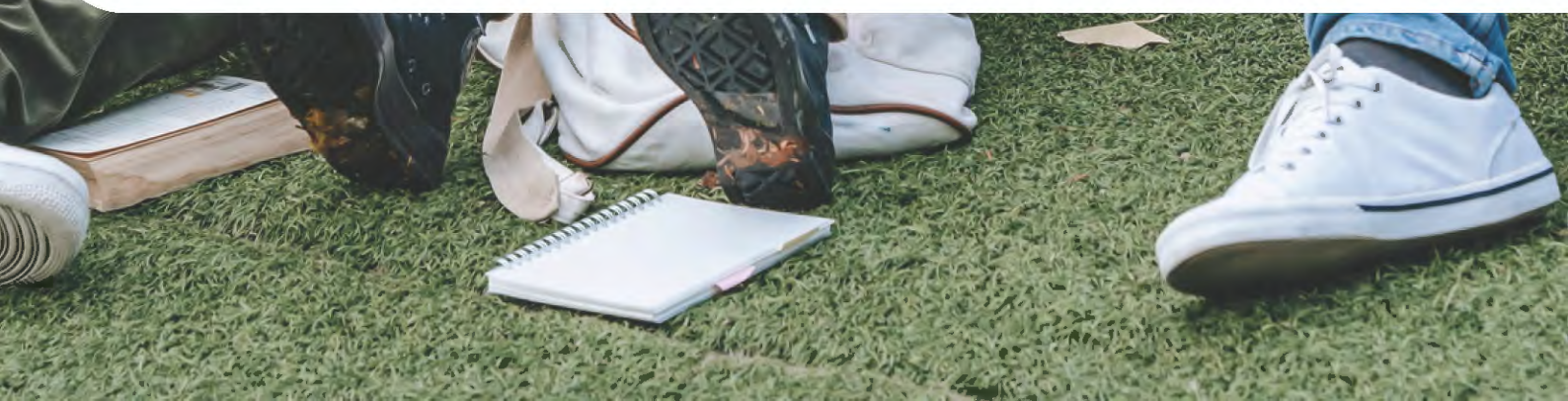

French grading system

- Score between 15/20 and 20/20 = very good score
- Score between 10/20 and 14/20 = average score
- Score between 7/20 and 9/20 = insufficient score
- Score between 0/20 and 6/20 = very insufficient score
- A 0/20 is not often given but demonstrates that the student could not be graded. It is given when a student misses an exam, did not provide the work required or in case of cheating.

At KEDGE, students are awarded ECTS credits. The majority of our courses offer either 4 or 5 ECTS credits. We consider a standard workload to range from 20 to 30 ECTS per semester.

HOUSING
