COURSES

Programmes and course workload: Exchange students choose courses from our English taught Bachelor and MSc programmes as well as English taught elective courses. A full semester workload is 30 ECTS credits. Master courses equal 6 ECTS credits. Bachelor courses equal 7,5 ECTS credits. NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCESS

Exchange coordinators nominate students online. Login information is sent to partner institutions before the nomination portal opens. The following student data is required:

- First name and family name
- Date of birth
- Citizenship
- E-mail address
- Duration of stay: 1 or 2 semesters
- Programme: Exchange/Double Degree/QTEM/Summer School

Nomination deadlines:

- 25 April for Autumn semester
- 25 September for Spring semester

Nominated exchange student apply online. Link to the online application form is automatically sent to students by e-mail after nomination.

Students must upload the following documents with the application:

- Motivation letter
- Copy of passport (page with photo)
- Recent academic transcript

Application deadlines:

- 1 May for Autumn semester
- 1 October for Spring semester

HOUSING

BI guarantees off-campus housing to all international students who apply correctly within the deadline 1 May/1 October. Application fee of NOK 1000 applies to all.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE SKILLS

No English language test is required from nominated exchange students. Partners are trusted to select students with a high level of English proficiency.

Recommended: level B2; TOEFL 78; IELTS 6.0.

STUDY PERMIT AND ENTRY VISA

All student staying in Norway for more than 3 months must register with the Norwegian Immigration Authorities. The procedures differ according to the nationality of the student:

- Citizens of countries outside the EU/EEA must apply for a study
- permit (and entry visa, if applicable) before coming to Norway.Citizens of EU/EEA countries must register with authorities

Transcripts
