

Housing

Tilburg University does not offer on-campus accommodation, but we cooperate with student housing association WonenBreburg which provides furnished accommodation for international students. For the Spring semester, there is space for **all** incoming exchange students to reserve a room, and for at least **75%** of students joining us in the Fall semester. Once you are accepted to Tilburg University, you will be contacted by our dedicated <u>Housing Office</u> to explore the options.

How to apply for an exchange at Tilburg University

Eligibility requirements:

Bachelor / undergraduate exchange	Master / graduate exchange
We rely on our partner universities to nominate students who are proficient in English to CEFR level B2 (equivalent to the test scores found on our <u>website</u>). As of May 2024, we do not require IELTS/TOEFL certificates from applicants with mainland Chinese nationality.	We rely on our partner universities to nominate students who are proficient in English to CEFR level C1 (equivalent to the test scores found on our <u>website</u>). As of May 2024, we do not require IELTS/TOEFL certificates from applicants with mainland Chinese nationality.
At the time of nomination, students must have obtained 60 ECTS or equivalent home university credits for 1 year of study, successfully completed within their current Bachelor program.	Successfully completed an undergraduate program in a relevant field of studies (economics, business, law, social & behavioral sciences, humanities, theology).

Inclusive Mobility

Students of all backgrounds are welcome at Tilburg University, and a range of services are available for students who may require extra support. Once you are accepted for an exchange at Tilburg University, you will be informed about how to request special arrangements. More information can be found here.



How to apply for an exchange at Tilburg University



First, check with your home university whether Tilburg University is one of their exchange partners and apply first through your home university. Partner universities can then submit details of their nominated students via our online nomination platform – the link will be sent to them near to the nomination period.



Nomination deadlines Fall and Full-Year: 1st May Spring: 1st October

Due to the greater number of students in the Fall semester and consequent high demand for housing, we strongly recommend nominating students for a Spring semester exchange when possible.



Our **Immigration** coordinators process visa applications for all incoming students who require a visa and/or residence permit. Note that the Dutch Immigration Service (IND) charges a fee for your visa and/or residence permit and you will need to show proof of finances. More information can be found here.



Once nominated, you will be invited to apply for your exchange via our mobility platform. You'll need to upload your official transcript of records in English and any additional documents that might be needed for specific courses (i.e. a motivation letter).
