#### ACADEMICS

Northeastern offers over 150 undergraduate majors and concentrations. The most popular areas of study are business, health, and engineering. Our entire learning model is centered around your success. Students take 3-4 courses for a full-time course load worth 12-16 credits. Labs and recitations are generally 1 credit hour. Northeastern operates on a semester system, and courses are taught in English. Competitive applicants will show excellent overall grades, with a minimum of a 2.5 or higher GPA on a 4.0 scale.

#### VISAS & ACCOMODATION

3. Submit your passport, transcript and proof of English proficiency in the online application
