#### What is Impact Lab?

Impact Lab is a groundbreaking program offered at The University of Hong Kong, aimed at bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical skills. Our core mission is to provide a platform for students to translate their academic learning into tangible, meaningful contributions that directly enhance societal well-being.

Since its establishment in 2013, the Impact Lab Course has welcomed a total of 1,304 students from diverse backgrounds. Representing 65 countries and spanning nearly every faculty within the University, this diverse student body reflects the inclusive and multidisciplinary approach of the program.

Collectively, our students have dedicated an impressive 156,480 hours of service in collaboration with 40 social impact organizations. This effort, valued at roughly HK\$10,953,600, has resulted in positive outcomes that have touched the lives of many, driving impactful change within both local and global communities.

More than just an academic course, Impact Lab offers a transformative experience that empowers future leaders with the skills and mindset to effect enduring social change.




The range of students in Impact Lab was incredibly diverse, and when we all got together in the workshops, it almost felt like we were transported beyond the borders of Hong Kong.







#### **Mentoring Program**

The Impact Lab Mentoring Program connects Impact Lab alumni and professionals with students and recent graduates to provide career guidance, share knowledge and experience, and shape the future of the Impact Lab community. This is a valuable opportunity that allows alumni to hone their leadership and communication skills, build their network, and learn about other organizations and industries through their mentees. This year, we have accumulated support from 13 brilliant mentors who helped enhance the Impact Lab experience for 28 student mentees.



#### **10th Anniversary Celebration**

The robust growth of social entrepreneurship in the past decades was a fueling power behind the introduction of the Impact Lab Course in 2013 (then called the Social Venture Management Course). To celebrate the 10th anniversary of this award-winning experiential learning course, a ceremony was held at HKU iCube in 2023 and attracted more than a hundred guests, including partners, NGO representatives, students and alumni.

## **Way Forward**

#### **Building an Open Online Course**

After trialling a 10-part seminar series on what it takes to start and run an impactful business, we are now working towards building and publishing a pilot version of the "Starting an Impacful Business" course to make it accessible to the wider community and empower a broader group of youth.



#### **Expansion to Summer Opportunities**

We hope to further expand our students' opportunities by creating more overseas and summer programs. These programs will entail students working with local communities to bring about social impact ideas that can be developed in the area and honing their leadership skills.



#### **Mentoring & Buddy Program**

In the Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 semesters, we successfully launched our first Impact Lab Mentoring Program with 28 mentees and 13 mentors. Adding value to the existing course structure, this Mentoring Program involves mentors from our corporate partners and alumni network, helping our students navigate their early professional lives and enrich their Impact Lab experience.
