- 2) Academic merit (a CGPA of 3.0 or above at the time of application)
- 3) No academic misconduct

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1) Review of application documents
- 2) Individual interview
 - Shortlisted students will be notified of the interview details in late October/ early November 2021

CRITERIA

- 1) Academic merits (CGPA of 3.0 or above)
- 2) Leadership role/ duties and its impacts
- 3) Scope and nature of the programme/ event/ association participated
- 4) Interview performance
- 5) No academic misconduct





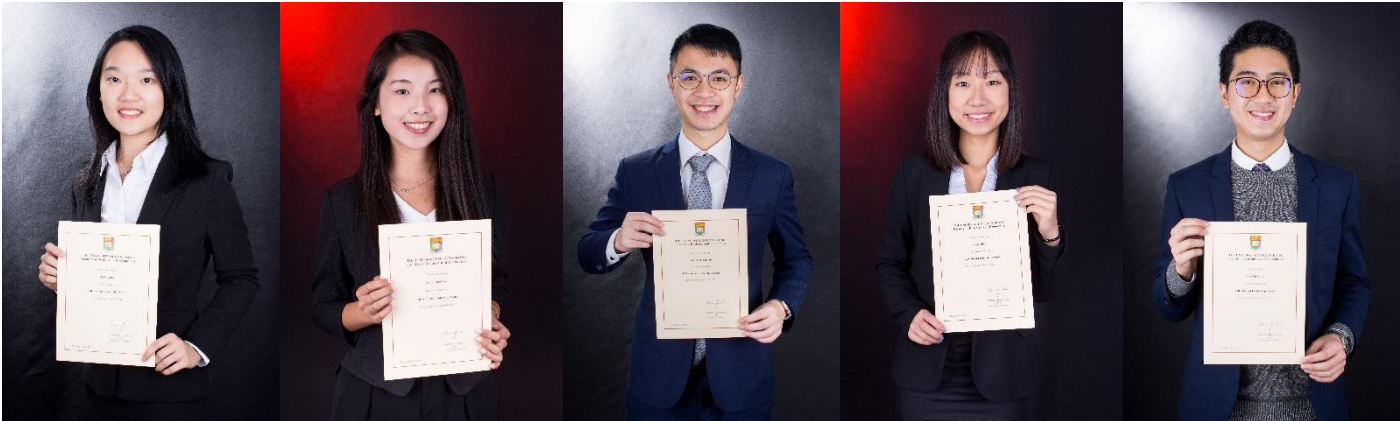
