#### **Programme Costs**

Fully sponsored (refundable deposit of HK\$2,000 required)

#### Covered Costs

- Accommodation, most meals, company visits, high-speed rail tickets and local transportation
- Students must cover travel insurance, visa fees (if applicable), and entertainment expenses





#### Online Application

- Application Deadline: February 21, 2025 (12:00 noon)
- Steps for Application:
  - Submit the online application with required documents:
    - 1. Passport-size photo
    - 2. Copy of travel document (e.g., Mainland Entry Permit / China Resident ID / Passport)
    - 3. 300-word essay on:
      - Interest in GBA and its development
      - Career aspirations and how the programme will help achieve them
  - Note: Shortlisted students may be invited for a group interview in early March 2025







#### Commitment and Expectations

- Selected student participants are required to pay a refundable deposit of HK\$2,000 upon acceptance of offer.
- For deposit refund, students are required to:
  - Attend the post-trip session AND deliver presentations and reflection sharing
  - Fully participate in the whole programme
  - Be proactive to learn during the whole programme
