Facilities in Fudan University

- Fudan student ID card will be issued to all students.
- With the student ID card, you can have access to facilities in Fudan University, including computer center, library, sports centre, canteen, printing shops, supermarket, etc.
- RMB1,000 will be added to your Student ID card. You can buy your meals at the canteen or other items on campus with the card.

Things you need to bring



- Please make sure that you bring along the following items to Shanghai:
 - ID card, valid Home Return Permit, passport or tourist visa to Mainland China (if applicable)
 - Mobile phone (phone card will be available at Fudan campus which costs RMB100 per card)
 - Cash (for transportation, leisure activities & etc.)
 (Currency exchange services will also be available in Fudan)
 - Adaptors/Plugs for Mainland China (220 V)
